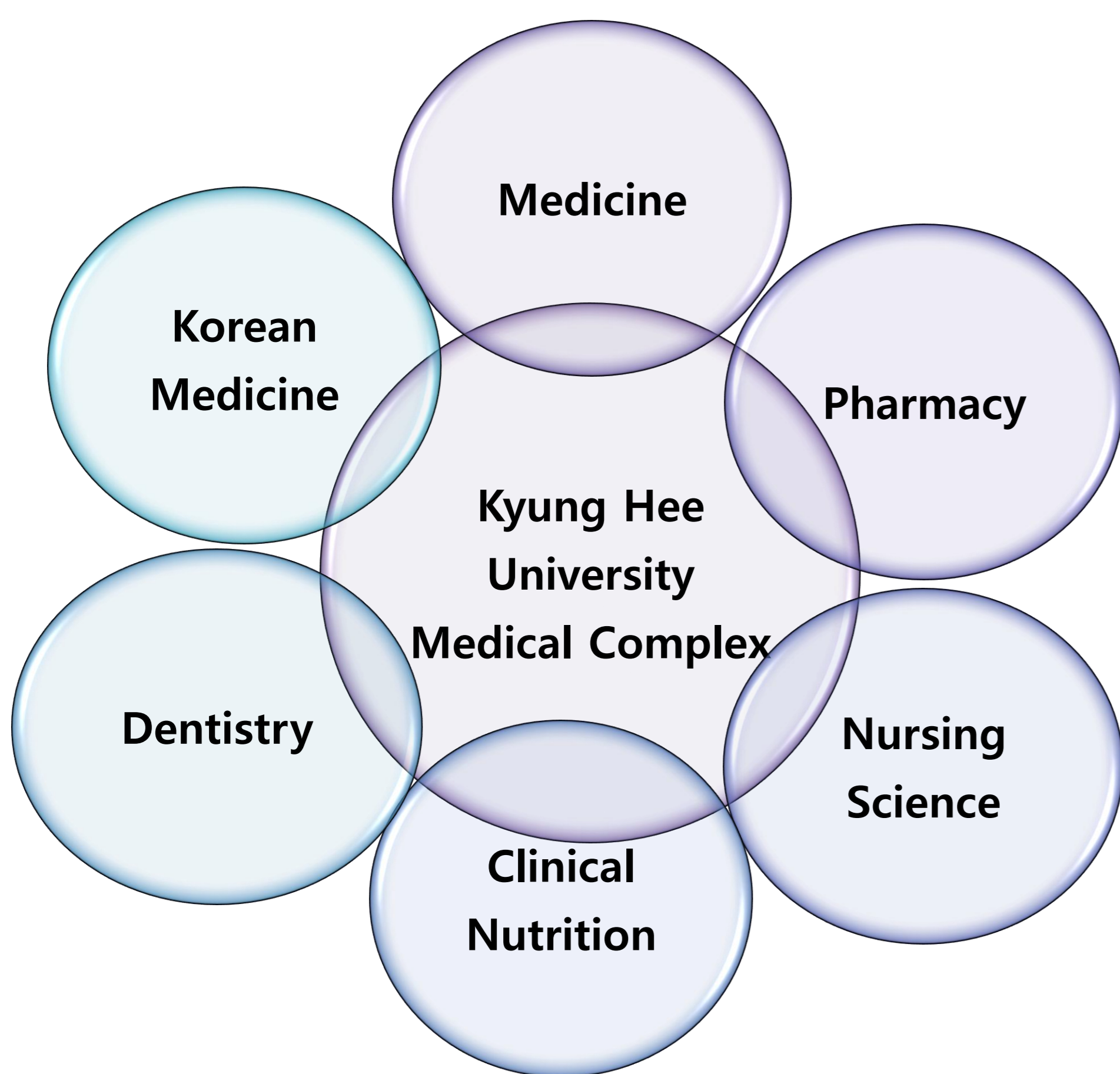

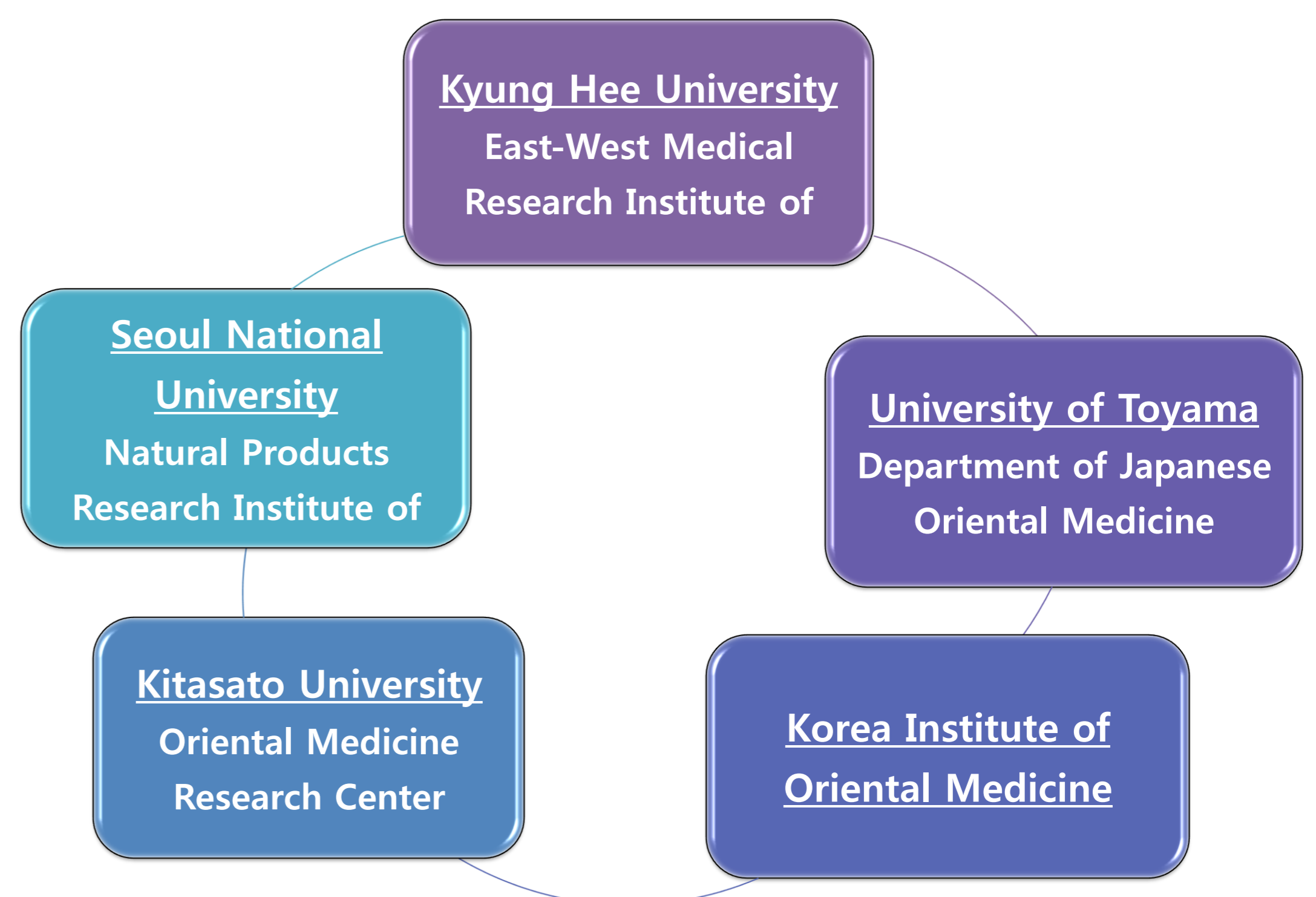
To participate in government policies on Traditional Medicine
