- The Korean WHO-FIC Collaborating Centre has played a bridging role in improving the interoperability of health information both at a local and international level.

  - 1) Participating in the development, update and revision of WHO-FIC such as ICD-11 revision process
  - 2) Laying the groundwork for implementation of ICD, ICF, ICTM and ICHI through researches, conferences and international cooperation

- **ICF newly translated into Korean language** and set to publish officially in Sep. 2015
- **ICD-11 Multilingual Platform** developed and pilot-tested in translating ICD-11 frozen version into Khmer (Cambodia) language
- **ICD Trainer Webpage** developed and being operated by Social Security Information Service
- **ICTM Beta version** developed and pilot-tested by Korean professionals
- **WHO internship program** conducted for health & medical students in partnership with WHO-CTS
