## Activities of Collaborating Center

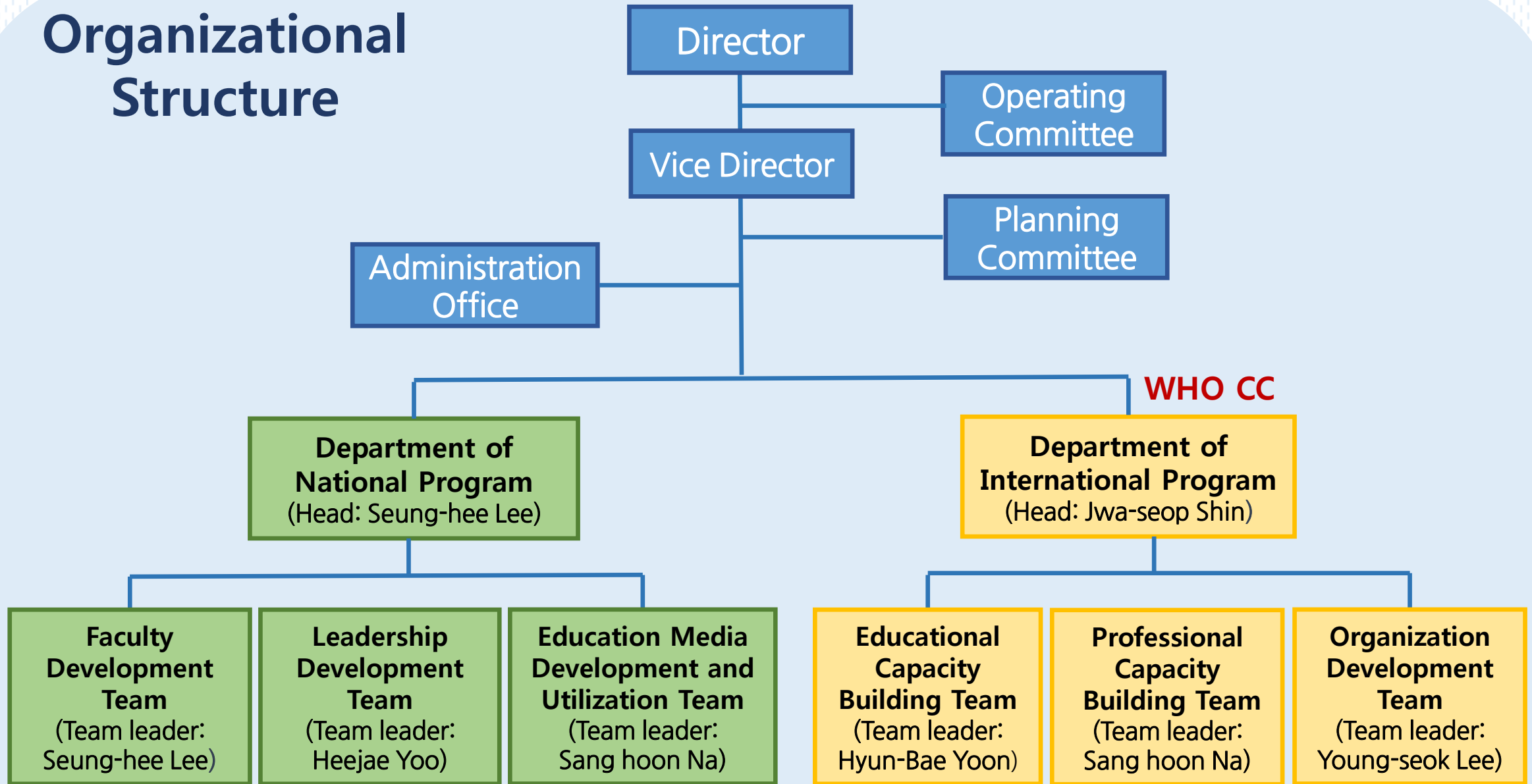
- Short-term international fellowship program in Korea to strengthen the capacity of health professional education of partner countries

# Role of each Team at CC

## Educational Capacity Building team

- Training health professional education experts in developing countries
